The PlayMaker Award

The PlayMaker Award is a nationally recognised Sports Leaders award. Over six sessions, pupils are provided with basic leadership skills that will allow them to boost their confidence, improve attainment and help promote healthy lifestyles.

Delivered as part of the school curriculum or as an extra curricular activity, the award is a great development programme for increasing confidence in young learners and giving them vital skills to help future development and transition into secondary school.

Energy Club

With a growing body of evidence indicating that physical activity and healthy lifestyle education benefits health and academic performance, our easy to use resources will positively contribute to a healthy and successful school.

Energy Club is set of resources for 4-11 year olds that can be used alongside the PlayMaker Award (or separately) and feature over 120 activities that are designed to be fun and inclusive. The activities can be delivered by school staff or older pupils who have undertaken the PlayMaker Award.



What do schools get from the Primary Leaders licence?

In addition to increased achievement and engagement of children, schools will also build an army of young helpers and volunteers. These learners can put their learning into practice and act as role models for other students and assist teachers during break-times, at open evenings, and at community events.

The framework used to deliver the PlayMaker Award has been specially designed and refined to be inclusive for all pupils. This is not an award just for the 'sporty'. It can be used to encourage and build the confidence of 'the less engaged, shy' pupils, and those with challenging behaviour – the latter often benefiting from having a focus and receiving recognition for success.
